The Community

The Village of Ottawa Hills is a small residential community located on the western edge of Toledo, Ohio. It is composed of approximately 1,800 households and 4,500 residents. Residents share an ongoing commitment to educational excellence.

Awards and Recognitions

Ottawa Hills Local Schools is the only school district in Ohio to achieve all A's for three straight years for the Ohio Department of Education's local report card ratings. The high school is also the recipient of the Governor's Thomas Edison Awards for Excellence in STEM Education and Student Research.

The high school was one of only 19 schools in Ohio to receive a gold medal rating by *U.S. News & World Report*. The website *24/7 Wall St.* also rated Ottawa Hills as the top school district in Ohio. In 2015, the high school was ranked as the number one public high school in Ohio and the 45th best school in the U.S. by *Newsweek*.

Accreditations

Ottawa Hills High School is accredited by the Ohio Department of Education and by AdvancED through the North Central Association of Colleges and Schools.

As a member of the National Association for College Admission Counseling (NACAC) and the Ohio Association for

College Admission Counseling (OACAC), Ottawa Hills High School adheres to the Principles of Good Practice governing college admissions and financial aid.

High School and Faculty

Ottawa Hills High School is a publicly supported institution with approximately 300 students. All students pursue a rigorous college preparatory program. Over 98% of our graduates pursue higher education, with over 96% attending four-year institutions.

Ottawa Hills High School has 30 faculty members, with an 11:1 student to faculty ratio. Of the faculty members, 72% hold at least a Masters degree in their respective field. The average classroom size is 18.

More than 90% of our students participate in extracurricular activities ranging from athletics to student-led clubs and organizations.

The Class of 2019

There are 84 members of the Class of 2019. All members of the graduating class took the state mandated ACT in March 2018. In addition, 5 have been identified as Semifinalists and 1 as a Commended Student for the 2019 National Merit Scholarship Competition.

Grading Scale

GPA is calculated on a weighted 4.0 scale and includes all high school level courses taken at Ottawa Hills.
